also has eight content-area committees that advise the organization regarding the standards and assessments in Pre-K-12 schools. They help NYSUT provide a professional response to Regents' initiatives.

#### Union

NYSUT is a federation of approximately 1,300 local unions representing 600,000 members statewide.

NYSUT members serve in a variety of capacities, including teachers, School-Related Professionals, academic and professional faculty in higher education, professionals in education and health care, municipal, county and state professionals, employees in libraries and non-profit organizations, and retirees. They belong to local affiliates ranging in size from the 200,000-member United Federation of Teachers in New York City to locals of fewer than 10 members. More than 95 percent of the teachers in New York's public elementary and secondary schools are members of NYSUT, along with many other pre-K-12 school employees, including teacher aides and teaching assistants, secretaries, custodians, bus drivers, food service personnel, health care professionals, nurses, security personnel and therapists. NYSUT also represents private school and charter school employees.

The academic and professional staffs of the State University, City University and many community colleges and private-sector colleges are members, as are thousands of nurses, psychologists, physicians and other professionals in health care facilities and other governmental agencies. When NYSUT members retire, they enjoy lifetime membership in both NYSUT and the American Federation of Teachers,

one of our two national affiliates. Retirees can join

NYSUT's other national affiliate, the National Education Association.
